Henry Lowe is a scientist who specializes in medicinal chemistry and for over forty (40) Years has worked in health sciences, wellness, technology and energy – nationally, regionally and internationally. He is an outstanding scientist, public servant, author, educator and a successful entrepreneur.

He was educated at Titchfield Primary, Calabar, Excelsior and of course the University of the West Indies. Post Graduate work was done at University of Sydney, Australia, Manchester University (U.K.), Bolton Institute of Technology (U.K.), Harvard University and M.I.T. (USA).

He has served the Government of Jamaica as Permanent Secretary, established the first Ministry of Science, Technology and Environment in the Caricom region, has been past president and CEO of Blue Cross of Jamaica and is now Chairman. He serves as Executive Chairman of the Environmental Health Foundation and Chairman of the Bureau of Standards, Jamaica and also as Chairman or member of at least a dozen other organizations in Jamaica.

He is a Senior Research Fellow at University of the West Indies, Mona and also Distinguished Professor of Ethno medicinal chemistry at University of Technology Jamaica.

Dr. Lowe's most recent entrepreneurial activity was the establishment of Eden Gardens, the first Wellness and Lifestyle Centre in the Caribbean. He has published over fifteen (15) books – the latest one concerning Jamaican Bush Teas and has written over one hundred (100) articles published in journals and the popular press.
